She currently owns Focal Point Solutions where she stores records and has recovered thousands of documents, and media from fire and flood.

Take the South Exit out of the airport through the toll booths; Take the Highway 360/Arlington exit, which bears to the right; Exit 1/4 mile onto access road to FAA Road; Continue to the three way stop; Go straight through intersection; Proceed 500 yards; Turn right through Main Gate; Follow signs for The Lodge/Lobby.
Ms. Perry is Past President of the Association of Records Managers and Administrators (ARMA) Ft. Worth Chapter. She served on the Standards Advisory and Development Committee for ARMA International for over 6 years. She was the Project Manager and co-author of "Vital Records" and other technical publications that have been submitted to ANSI as a standard. She is a member of the Association of Information and Image Management (AIIM) and the South Trinity Blvd/FAA Road exit: Go through the traffic light at Trinity Blvd to FAA Road; Turn left at the stop sign and go back over the highway: At three ways stop make left: proceed 500 yards; Turn right through Main Gate; Follow signs for The Lodge/Lobby.
Ms. Perry is considered an expert in the document management industry and is a frequent lecturer at meetings, seminars and workshops. Ms. Perry and her company have recovered millions of micrographic images for companies across the United States.

From Lovefield Airport:

Take the main exit road out of the airport, at the stoplight at Mockingbird Lane take a right: Bypass the intersection of Interstate 35; at the next intersection - take 183 West to D/FW Airport, which bears to the right: Take the Highway 360/Arlington exit. Which bears to the right; Exit 1/4 mile onto access road to FAA Road: Continue to the three way stop. Go straight and proceed 500 yards: Turn right through Main Gate: Follow signs for The Lodge/Lobby.

From Arlington:

Take Highway 360 North to Trinity Blvd/ FAA Road exit; Go through the traffic light at Trinity Blvd to FAA Road; At the stop sign, turn left; Go back over the highway; At the three way stop, turn left and proceed 500 yards; Turn right through Main Gate; Follow signs for The Lodge/Lobby.

From Fort Worth on 1-20:

Take 1-20 East to Dallas; Take Highway 360 North to Trinity Blvd/FAA Road exit; Go through the traffic light at Trinity Blvd to FAA Road; At the stop sign, turn left; Go back over the highway; At the three way stop, turn left and proceed 500 yards; Turn right through Main Gate: Follow signs for The Lodge/Lobby.
