From Downtown Dallas

Go north on the Dallas North Tollway. Take the Spring Creek Parkway/Tennyson Parkway exit and drive north on the Dallas North Tollway frontage road. Go through the first stop light and turn right at the next stop light (Tennyson Parkway). Proceed east on Tennyson for 0.7 mile, and we are on the right, at the corner of Tennyson Parkway and Democracy Drive.

From DFW Airport

Take the North Airport exit. Take 121 North and go approximately 18.5 miles to Legacy Drive. Turn right on Legacy Drive and go 1.5 miles to Parkwood Blvd. Turn right on Parkwood Blvd. and go 0.4 mile to Tennyson Parkway. Turn left on Tennyson Parkway and go 0.5 mile to Democracy Drive. We are on the right, on the corner of Democracy Drive and Tennyson Parkway.

From Love Field

Exit south from Love Field and turn left (east) on Mockingbird. Turn left onto Dallas North Tollway. Take the Spring Creek Parkway/Tennyson Parkway exit and drive north on the Dallas North Tollway frontage road. Go through the first stop light and turn right at the next stop light (Tennyson Parkway). Proceed east on Tennyson for 0.7 mile, and we are on the right, at the corner of Tennyson Parkway and Democracy Drive.

From Houston

Interstate 45 to Dallas; merge onto Hwy. 75/Central Expwy/"To Sherman"; pass through Dallas, Richardson to Plano-approx. 20 miles; take Springcreek exit on north side of Plano, turn left on Springcreek, go west to Preston Rd., approx. 5 miles; turn right on Preston to first traffic light-Tennyson; turn left to stop sign-Democracy; turn left, our building is on the right corner: 5201 Democracy Dr.

Code of Conduct at Chapter Meetings

ASIS International has adopted a position on professional conduct at chapter meetings for members who supply goods or services.

As an organization of professional security practitioners, it is desirable that chapter meetings be held in an atmosphere free of uninvited commercial distractions. ASIS endorses a policy that prohibits members who provide and sell security or consulting services from initiating a sales effort immediately before, during, or after a chapter meeting while at the meeting location.

Adherence to this policy will result in maintaining an atmosphere in which members are able to discuss matters affecting their profession without being the object of a sales presentation. This policy does not prohibit an organized program wherein a service company may present the program from that day, nor does it prevent a member in the service industry from responding to an inquiry.
