Exit Airport via North Exit, proceed North to Dallas (East Exit to 635 East (LBJ Freeway).

Proceed East on 635 (LBJ Freeway) until it intersects with IH-75 (Central Expressway) North (Richardson-Plano) Exit onto 75N Proceed Northbound on IH-75 (Central Expressway) until you reach Renner Road exit. Exit at Renner Road Exit. Move to far Right Turn Only lane as you will have to exit to the Right onto Lakeside Blvd.

Dear ASIS Members:

It is imperative that security management professionals voice their support for the **ANSI/ASIS Organizational Resilience Standard** as a preparedness standard in the PS-Prep Program by submitting comments to the Federal Register Public Notice/Docket ID: FEMA-2008-0017. **Comments are due 11/15/09.** As I have been saying all year, Standards and Guidelines are going to be written. We need to be at the table in a leadership role and this is our opportunity.

**The following are instructions for submitting comments:**

- E-mail to: [fema-policy@dhs.gov](mailto:fema-policy@dhs.gov), (Identify Docket ID FEMA-2008-0017 in subject line); or
- Post them on-line at <http://www.regulations.gov>. (Click on "submit a comment" and follow instructions).

**Some Points to consider:**

- It is the only preparedness standard that takes an enterprise-wide view of risk management, enabling an organization to develop a comprehensive strategy to prevent when possible, prepare for, mitigate, respond to, and recover from a disruptive incident.
- It is also the only preparedness standard that is 100% compatible with existing ISO management system standards (such as ISO 9000, ISO 14000, ISO 27000 and ISO 28000), thus enabling a cost-saving integrated application.
- The choice of which standard to use should be what fits a company's business and management style. They all help improve preparedness, so any of the three standards identified in the Federal Register should be adopted by the PS-Prep Program.
